arie Aiello's killer instincts dissect Dexter's psyche against a gray palette ("He's not good, but not entirely bad," she observes), as well as materials and applications reflecting our blood-spatter analyst's discordant soul ("He's filled with conflict and fury—a broken man"). Dexter's shattered interior shows up in disordered planes of kitchen cabinetry and fractured shadows cast by the fireplace mantel's mirrored tiles. Discreet references to his gory proclivities also abound.

(1) The center "cut" in a dining room table surrounded by bondage-ready seatbelt chairs. (2) A blood droplet-like pendant lamp in the living room. (3) The knifeblade form of the kitchen island. (4) Tensile sail canopies on the terrace, designed with Aiello's husband, architect Paul Boardman, evoke the Miami locale.


E dgy and fierce, the Dexter-inspired kitchen is both functional and innovative. (1) Stainless steel and aluminum slice through cherry wood in a kitchen where the muse and the design become one. (2) Varying the size and placement of wall cabinets transforms above bar storage into a work of art. (3) Streamlined inside and out-wood tiered dividers keep the interior contents as sleek as the exterior design. (4) Wall Top Hinge cabinets combine with furniture drawers to maintain strong horizontal lines. Interior and under cabinet lighting shed the perfect amount of illumination. (5) Sparsely stacked Wall Top Hinge cabinets fit the space while preserving the balance and aesthetics of the design. (6) Peeling the many layers of texture and personality-Peppercorn cherry warms, Vetro aluminum doors cool while Satina glass leaves a hint of mystery.
